Fine, fresh and pronounced aromas. In the mouth, beautiful frame and persistent fruity finish.

Medium-intense straw yellow in colour. The nose reveals distinct notes of white flowers followed by fresher jasmine flowers and a crisp and delicate citrus vein. Striking for its decisiveness, medium body and feistiness, expressed through its fresh palate.

Fruit and minerality, aromatics and balanced freshness, coexist in this white wine that has made enjoyment and versatility its trademark.

Intriguing fenugreek seed and bacon fat aromas evolve into elderflower and citrus. On the palate, intense gooseberry and fenugreek dominate, with elderflower and honeysuckle providing some richness, followed up by slight mineral notes.

ALVAREZ DE TOLEDO GODELLO LEON \$ 88
SPAIN

Plump melon and stone fruit aromas are a touch broken down and mealy. This Godello feels fleshy and round, with pulpy weight. Tangerine and tropical fruit flavours weigh in on the heavy side, while the finish is chunky and pithy in flavour.

MISHA VINEYARD THE HIGH NOTE, PINOT NOIR
NEW ZEALAND

Ruby in colour with an expressive nose of plum stone, cinnamon, chocolate and hints of truffle, this Pinot Noir has a gentle silky palate with sweet fruit tempered by fine tannins, roasted wild herbs and a long lingering finish.

SPAIN

ALVAREZ DE TOLEDO, BIERZO
SPAIN

Ripe plum and violet aromas carry a slight note of prune. A beefy palate shows hard tannins but nothing too tough that food can't tame. Blackened, roasted blackberry and blueberry flavours finish with charred, meaty intensity.

PUJANZA HADO, LAGUARDIA
SPAIN

Light to medium ruby colour. Red berries and fresh, herbal aromas on the nose are followed by a fresh, light palate with herbal notes reflecting a cool vintage.

VALDUBON CRIANZA RIBERA DEL DUERO
SPAIN

Deep blood red colour. Overnotes of ripe plum, red berries, spicy notes of liquorice and thyme. Powerful & velvety with ripe tannins.

PREMIUM WINE

FRANCE – BORDEAUX

CHATEAU QUINTUS

\$ 750

Concentrated, very ripe nose with hints of black fruit and cocoa. Very full and supple on the palate. It is stunning that a wine this young is so round, with a certain harmony seemingly impervious to distortion—a sweet sensation which is the sign of maturity certainly plays a role here. Aromatic finish.

LE CLARENCE DE HAUT BRION

\$ 580

An equal blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon with a dash of Cabernet Franc, this wine is structured, serious and also approachable. Ripe, juicy fruit is in evidence under the firm structure and dusty tannins.

CHATEAU PLINCE

\$ 250

Chateau Plince is best paired with all types of classic meat dishes, roasted braised and grilled dishes. Chateau Plince is also good when matched with Asian dishes, hearty fish courses and pasta. Chateau Plince is a lighter, early drinking style of Pomerol wine.

CHATEAU CHANTALOUETTE POMEROL

\$ 208

Traditional racking and light egg white fining help to preserve the brightness of the fruit. 70% Merlot - 15% Cabernet Franc 15% Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine is charming, round, elegant, and approachable from a young age.

CHATEAU DE VALOIS (ORGANIC) POMEROL

\$ 198

The estate performs green harvests and canopy thinning to maintain yields. Expressive, pure, profound: 83% Merlot, 17% Cabernet Franc. Merlot reaches its apogee on the sandy, mineral-rich soils of Pomerol. Plum and summer berries; light liquorice and spice.

FRANCE – BURGUNDY

DOMAINE ROUX PERE & FILS GEVREY CHAMBERTIN VIELLES VIGNES

\$ 280

Produced from old vines planted upwards of 25 years ago, this well-structured wine has velvety tannins and is delicate on the palate. It is aromatic with notes of strawberry, mulberry, violet and rose with more complex fragrances like liquorice and leather developing with age.

DOMAINE VIEUX TELEGRAPHE TELEGRAMME CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RHONE

Vieux Télégraphe's second-label Châteauneuf-duPape red, made with the grapes of young vines under 30 years old, plus older parcels not located on the Plateaux of La Crau or Piedlong. Grenache 80%, Syrah 10%, Mourvèdre 6% and Cinsault 4%.

ITALY - VENETO

ALLEGRIANI AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO DOCG

\$ 380

Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Oseleta are left to air dry at least until December and are checked daily to ensure perfectly healthy grapes. Amarone's distinctive flavour compliments new and exotic sweet and sour dishes. It is therefore also perfect with Asian and middle-eastern dishes.
