

# MARBLE MOUNTAINS


Visit the Marble Mountains, a majestic ensemble of five elemental peaks, where natural beauty intertwines with spiritual significance.

# MY SON SANCTUARY



My Son is one of the most important sites of the ancient kingdom of Champa. Located in the heart of a beautiful valley and surrounded by high mountain ranges, My Son is one of the most stunning sights to see in Central Vietnam and only around 80 kilometers from Da Nang city. While excavating My Son, letters revealed that this complex had been used for offerings and worshiping the Hindu God since the 4<sup>th</sup> century.

In 1999, UNESCO declared My Son a **Unesco World Heritage Site**. The My Son Sanctuary is a remarkable architectural ensemble developed over ten centuries. It presents a vivid picture of spiritual and political life in an essential phase of the history of South-East Asia.

Originally built with wood, the temples in My Son were destroyed by fire in the 6<sup>th</sup> century and restored in the 7<sup>th</sup> century by Sambhuvarman, who rebuilt the temples with locally made bricks. Up to the 13<sup>th</sup> century, more than 70 similar temples were built, establishing My Son as a sanctuary of Hinduism in the Champa Kingdom.

Visiting My Son Sanctuary is not only a journey through time but also an opportunity to appreciate the cultural heritage of Vietnam. The site's natural beauty, nestled amidst lush greenery and surrounded by rolling hills, adds to the enchanting ambiance, making it a truly immersive and unforgettable experience.
