Along with 11 top rugby internationals they gather as a team to support their patron, Joost van der Westhuizen, one of the world's greatest scrum-halves every year at the Dubai – Rugby 7's. As well as sponsoring the legendary team's accommodation, meals and transportation, Novotel Dubai World Trade Centre hosted a stylish poolside dinner where the rugby-loving public enjoyed an evening with their favourite rugby heroes. A highlight of the evening was a live interactive session with Joost van der Westhuizen who was unfortunately unable to attend the event due to his ailing health condition.
