

# DISCOVER PATTAYA'S NATURAL CHARM

MEET THE NATIVE PLANTS THAT CALL CHONBURI HOME



Beyond the beaches and bright lights, Pattaya hides a greener side — one filled with wild blooms, tropical scents, and stories rooted in Thai nature. Take a moment to wander off the main road and meet some native plants that make the eastern coast truly alive.



## **Kaempferia chonburiensis (Chonburi Ginger)**

**Where:** Forest paths near Khao Chi Chan, Nong Nooch Tropical Garden  
A rare wild ginger discovered right here in Chonburi! Its lilac-purple flowers appear after the rain — tiny bursts of color close to the forest floor.

## **Wrightia religiosa (Water Jasmine)**

**Where:** Naklua, Sattahip temple gardens, and quiet canals  
Soft white petals, a calming fragrance, and gentle branches that sway in the breeze — the Water Jasmine is often planted for meditation and serenity.



## **Globba winitii (Dancing Ladies Ginger)**

**Where:** Shaded forest trails of Banglamung and Khao Mai Kaew  
Look for its elegant purple and yellow “dancers” beneath the trees. Locals say these blooms resemble graceful Thai dancers — a hidden show in nature.

# WILDLIFE OF PATTAYA

## NATURE BEYOND THE BEACH

Discover the wild side of Chonburi! From forested hills to seaside gardens, these native species remind us that nature is never far away.

### **LONG-TAILED MACAQUE** (*Macaca fascicularis*)

**WHERE:** *Khao Chi Chan, Wat Yansangwararam*

Curious and playful — you'll spot them near temples and forest trails. Observe quietly, and they might strike a pose!

### **VARIABLE SQUIRREL** (*Callosciurus finlaysonii*)

**WHERE:** *Naklua parks, Jomtien Beach, Silverlake, and forest edges*

Quick, agile, and often seen leaping between palm trees — these colorful squirrels add a lively touch to Pattaya's green corners!

### **MONITOR LIZARD** (*Varanus salvator*)

**WHERE:** *Sattahip wetlands & park ponds in Pattaya*

Graceful and calm, these gentle giants often bask under the sun or swim lazily in canals.

### **TOKAY GECKO** (*Gekko gekko*)

**WHERE:** *Garden villas, forest lodges, local homes*

Famous for its echoing "To-kay!" call — a charming night guardian of Thai houses.
