 <p>Wat Saket (Phu Khao Thong)</p>	7:00 - 19:00 hrs	<p>Boripat Road, Khwaeng Ban Bat, Khet Pom Prap Sattru Phai</p> <p>How to get there: Mrt Sam Yot and walk 16 minutes</p>	For women, cover the shoulders and chest area and wear bottoms that go past the knees. For men, long pants and shirts with sleeves are required. Visitors need to take off their shoes and leave them on the shelves outside before entering any of the religious buildings.

 <p>Benjakiti Park</p>	4:30 - 22:00 hrs	<p>Rama IV Rd, Lumpini, Pathumwan, Bangkok 10330, Thailand</p> <p>How to get there: Take BTS to Asoke Station. The park is walking distance from here.</p>	There is no strict Dress Code
 <p>Pathum Wanaruk Park</p>	10:00 - 18:00 hrs	<p>57 Witthayu Rd, Pathum Wan, Bangkok 10330, Thailand</p> <p>How to get there: Take the skywalk going to Central World. You can cross through the shopping mall or use the sidewalk.</p>	There is no strict Dress Code

 <p>Pathumwanaram Temple</p>	09:00 – 16:00 hrs	<p>Between Siam Paragon and Central World</p> <p>How to get there: Walking Distance</p> <p>BTS Siam</p>	Make sure your shoulders are covered (no vests, tank tops or spaghetti straps) and although skirts or shorts are acceptable at many temples, they should be smart and at least knee-length
 <p>Erawan Shrine</p>	06:00 – 00:00 hrs	<p>Opposite the Central World</p> <p>How to get there: Walking Distance BTS Siam or BTS Chidlom</p>	There is no strict Dress Code
 <p>Bangkok Art & Culture Center</p>	10:00 – 21:00 hrs (Close on Monday)	<p>Opposite MBK Mall</p> <p>How to get there: Walking Distance BTS National Stadium</p>	There is no strict Dress Code. Recommend wearing something versatile, as it is hot outside but a bit cold inside because of the notorious air-conditioning.
 <p>Wat Arun</p>	8:00 -17:30 hrs	<p>158 Wang Doem Road, Wat Arun, Bangkok Yai, Bangkok</p> <p>How to get there Mrt Sanam Chai Exit 2 and take a boat 10 minutes</p>	visitors must wear culturally appropriate clothing to visit. This means trousers or long skirts and tops that cover your shoulders. It also means nothing see-through.
 <p>Grand Palace</p>	8:30 - 15:30 hrs	<p>Phra Borom Maha Ratchawang</p> <p>How to get there Mrt Sanam Chai exit 1 and walk from station 15 minutes</p>	Men must wear long pants; women must cover legs to just above the knee. Avoid wearing tight-fitting stretch pants or “revealing” clothing. Don't wear sleeveless shirts or show shoulders. Don't wear shirts with religious themes or symbols of death (heavy metal t-shirts)
