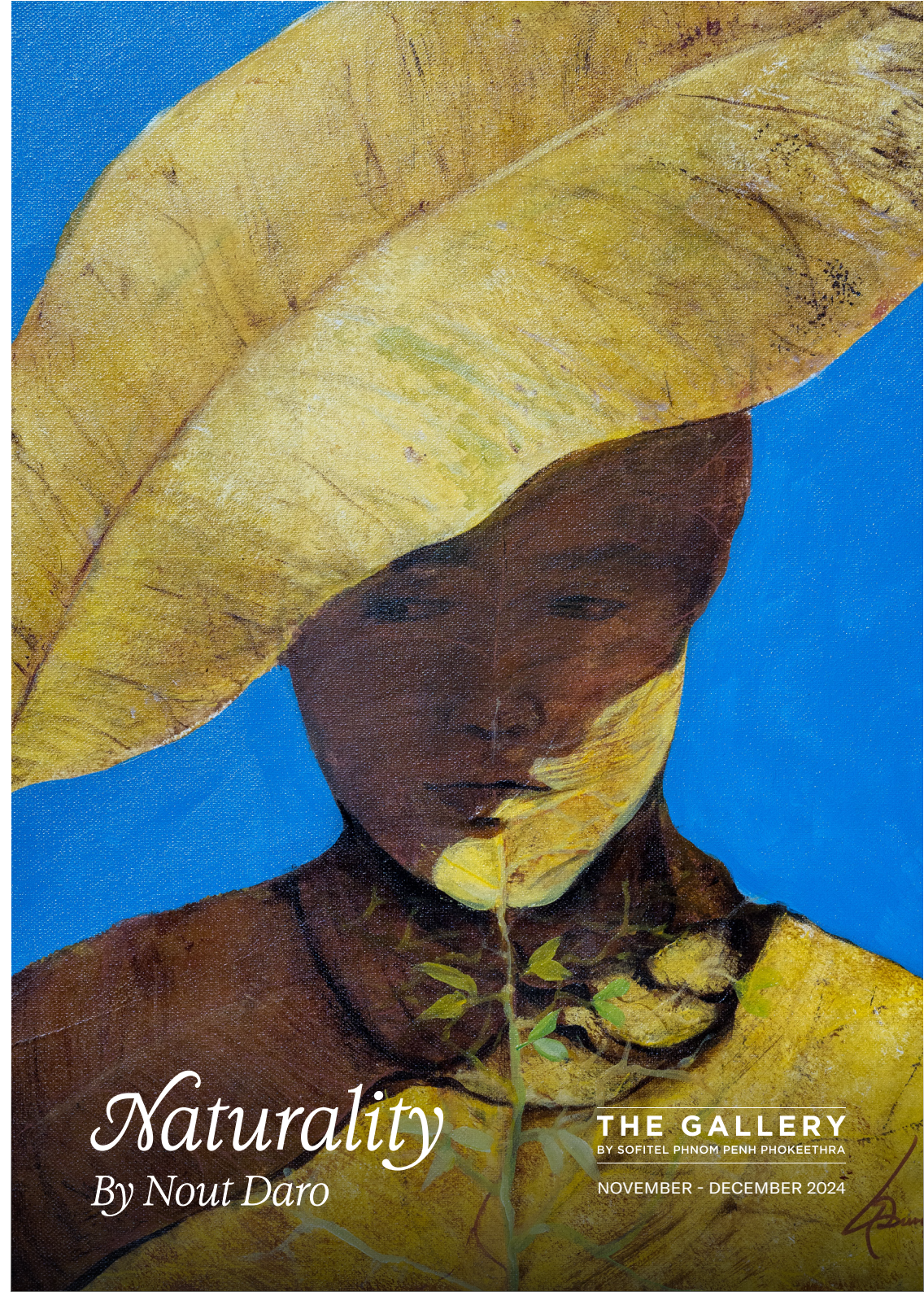

Afterward, he volunteered with NGOs, refining his drawing and sculpture skills and discovering his artistic identity. His unique style, supported by both national and international audiences, has led to his success as a young Cambodian painter.

Daro has participated in numerous exhibitions and auctions, both locally and abroad. He currently teaches art at international schools in Cambodia, including Yamada School of Art and AUPP High School. In 2022, he won third place in the National Art Festival's watercolor competition and, in 2023, exhibited in an international show in Singapore. Most recently, in 2024, he won first prize (Jury Award) in Ekari each competition by Sofitel Phnom Penh Phokeethra.

He also contributes to charity art events, such as the recent "Infinity" Charity Art Exhibition & Auction.

In his "Naturality" series, Daro draws inspiration from fallen leaves, viewing them as nature's art. His work combines nature, life, and culture, using his signature "Sunrise colors," which reflect the energy of the sun and its role in the cycle of life. He hopes his art inspires others to love and protect nature.
